



SIERRA VISTA METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION EMERGENCY PRE-EMPTION SIGNAL PROJECT

In partnership with ADOT's SouthCentral District, the Town of Huachuca City and the Whetstone Fire Dept., emergency pre-emption signals will be installed on Highway 90 to alert, slow and stop high-speed traffic on Highway 90, to allow faster response times for emergency services. This project will include advance signs, alerting the traveling public to the presence of two fire stations, and combine existing street lighting with new mast arms.

Solar emergency beacons in the Whetstone area were activated the summer of 2020. Activation of the signal at School Drive occurred in December 2020.

Final inspections are expected to be completed by March of 2021.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

An emergency pre-emption signal is a way for emergency vehicles to obtain safe access to a roadway or highway prior to their arrival to an intersection. This allows those emergency vehicles to have faster response times and decreases conflicts with emergency services and the traveling public.
