## NORTH GARDEN/FRY BLVD PROJECT

A conceptual design study was completed for the West End area in 2017. Business owners along this historic entryway to Fort Huachuca and the City of Sierra Vista were looking for a distinctive look that encouraged a pedestrian friendly environment. At the same time, potential improvements in efficiency, reliability and safety for key downtown intersections and corridors were identified.

This project is the first phase of construction towards enhancing the West End transportation circulation. Final Design is anticipated to be complete in 2021, with construction anticipated by 2022. .

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The HURF Exchange Program allows funds to be passed through the Arizona Dept. of Transportation, from the SVMPO, directly to the City of Sierra Vista as per an executed IGA for reimbursement of expended funds towards the approved project. Project Management falls to the City of Sierra Vista, under the guidelines of the HURF Exchange Program.



This project includes a conceptual schematic for the entire project length but construction funding for only Phase 1: portions of Fry Blvd. between N. Garden Ave and 7<sup>th</sup> Ave. Later phases may include additional improvements on N. Garden Ave. to Buffalo Solider Trail and intersections along Fry. Blvd.
